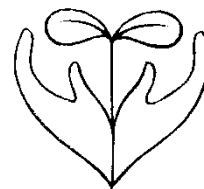
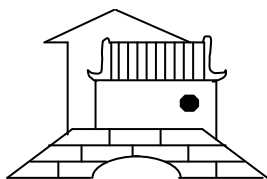

Below are some reminders which need your attention:

4. **Halloween Parade (10/28 Wed.):** Please prepare for your child a Halloween costume that day and we will have a parade in the gym. The school has some extra

costumes for those who need them; please let the teachers know if you are interested.
